

Keyguards, anyone?

One of the new developments we are most excited about this fall is our purchase of two high-quality, large-format 3D printers! Many of our grant applicants request keyguards for their communication devices. These simple tools, designed to fit over speech-generating devices to help improve manual input accuracy, are surprisingly expensive. Depending on app layout and attachment method, they will typically range between \$50 and \$150. With our new 3D printers, we are able to create our own keyguards, customized to the user's app layout, tablet, and case model, at a fraction of the cost.

All grant recipients of Adler's Voice who have requested a keyguard as part of their application will receive a customized keyguard for free. In the coming months, we hope to extend our program and offer our custom keyguards also to families, school districts, speech-language pathologists, and other support professionals throughout the state of Oregon for a nominal cost to cover time and materials. Soon we will be posting instructions for ordering a keyguard, complete with templates and guides for taking proper measurements, on our website.
